Domaine Serene seeks a driven Cellar Assistant. This position will report to the Cellar Master and work closely with the entire winemaking team to produce wines of international significance. This is a full-time hourly position. Domaine Serene offers a generous compensation package including paid leave + 10 holidays, medical insurance including dental and vision, a 401k plan and a yearly wine allocation.

We are Domaine Serene, America's Most Acclaimed Winery. Founded in 1989 by Ken and Grace Evenstad, we are the only winery in the world to have secured a top 3 or better ranking for Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from Wine Spectator's coveted Top 100 Wines of the Year list. Located at the top of the Dundee Hills in the Northern Willamette Valley, Domaine Serene's picturesque Winery Hill Estate is home to one of the world's most advanced winemaking facilities, and most luxurious tasting experience facilities. Evenstad Estates owns and meticulously manages over 1,000 acres of land, including 275 acres of hillside Pinot Noir and Chardonnay vineyards, all of which are dry-farmed and LIVE certified sustainable.

In 2015, the Evenstads purchased Château de la Créé, a 15th-century chateau and state of the art winery located in Santenay, Burgundy. With 25 acres of sustainably farmed vineyards throughout the Côte de Beaune, the French portfolio in Burgundy consists of three brands: Les Tourelles de la Créé, Château de la Créé, and Maison Evenstad.

Mission: The Cellar Assistant will be responsible for carrying out day-to-day operations and perform tasks such as topping, transfers, filtration, forklifting, sanitation, and basic maintenance of equipment. They will also support bottling, shipping/receiving, and warehouse operations. During the harvest season, the Cellar Assistant is expected to provide leadership and training for seasonal staff.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Performs cellar activities such as wine movements, topping, additions, and filtration.
- Cleans, sanitizes, and sterilizes all winery equipment and facilities.
- Accurately follows and completes work orders.
- Maintains a clean, tidy, and safe work environment.
- Takes ownership of all barrel work (cleaning & sanitation, receiving, tracking, filling, topping, racking, etc.)
- Assists in harvest operations: vineyard sampling, fruit receive and processing, cap management, additions, inoculations, pressing and barrel downs.
- Trains and supervises seasonal staff during harvest.
- Collects samples.
- Assists in bottling operations.
- Assists with warehouse operations and the shipping and receiving of goods.
- Performs basic equipment maintenance (hose repair, maintaining pumps, etc.).
- Maintains an accurate inventory of wine and winemaking supplies.
- Follows example set by Cellar Master and senior production employees regarding winery performance standards.
- Participates in Domaine Serene winery sustainability efforts.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Self-motivated, good-humored, vigilant, adaptable, punctual, and responsible.
- Has the ability to multi-task and work independently in a fast-paced, high-pressure environment while maintaining an emphasis on quality, efficiency, and safety.
- Able to adapt and grow within a fast-paced, dynamic organization.
- Ability to speak/write proficiently in English and follow written and verbal instructions.
- Operates a forklift with confidence and competence.

Requirement and Qualifications:

- 1+ year(s) of wine production experience.
- Enology, Viticulture or wine studies degree/certificate is a plus.
- Demonstrate a clear passion for wine & the winemaking process.
- Ability to work flexible hours, evenings and weekend, especially during peak times of the year: harvest, bottling, tirage, etc.
- Be able to lift at least 50 pounds.
- Safely and repeatedly lift 50 pounds.
- Valid driver's license and reliable personal transportation.
