Consistent from vintage to vintage as the “little sister” of the Evenstad Reserve Pinot Noir, the Yamhill Cuvée Pinot Noir is a blend from each of our vineyard sites that results in a vibrant, food friendly Pinot Noir.

The 2011 Yamhill Cuvée is a blend of Pinot Noir clones sourced primarily from our estate vineyards in the Dundee Hills and Eola Hills. This wine offers a broad array of aromatic characters, with notes of cherry, exotic spice, rose petal and kirsch. The aromas carry through on the palate with a classy textural profile that is sweet, silky and persistent.
