The Mark Bradford Vineyard is a high elevation site located on the west-facing slope of the Evenstad Estate. It was the first Pinot Noir vineyard planted for Domaine Serene and is named after owners, Grace and Ken Evenstad's son.

The 2012 Mark Bradford is a powerful wine, offering layers of complexity. The aroma profile consists of black currant, boysenberry, mocha, leather, wild game, cinnamon stick, smoke and chocolate covered cherries. This dynamic wine delivers a serious, rich palate with focused tannins and lingering flavor intensity.
