A premium Oregon Pinot Noir with consistency vintage to vintage due to the blending of Pinot Noir from each of our main estates. Named for the county where all of the Domaine Serene estates are found, the inaugural vintage of this blend pre-dates the designation of the Yamhill-Carlton AVA and includes grapes from the Dundee Hills and Eola-Amity AVAs.

The 2012 Yamhill Cuvée offers an alluring nose rich with aromas of Bing Cherry, blackberry, and sarsaparilla. The aromas carry through on the palate and burst with intense fruit that is completely integrated with playful tannins, finishing with spicy notes. The textural profile is refined, silky, persistent and incredibly pleasing for any occasion.
