Mark Bradford Vineyard is a high elevation site located on the west-facing slope of the Evenstad Estate. It was the first vineyard planted at Domaine Serene, and is named after Grace and Ken Evenstad's son. This dynamic wine delivers a serious, rich palate with focused tannins and lingering flavor intensity.

The 2013 Mark Bradford is a powerful Pinot Noir that offers up an enticing bouquet of black cherries intertwined with notes of black tea and spice. The wine is rich and layered with fine tannins and a plush mouthfeel. The palate is focused and structured with an explosion of black cherry and blackberries leading to a long focused finish that is silky and persistent.
